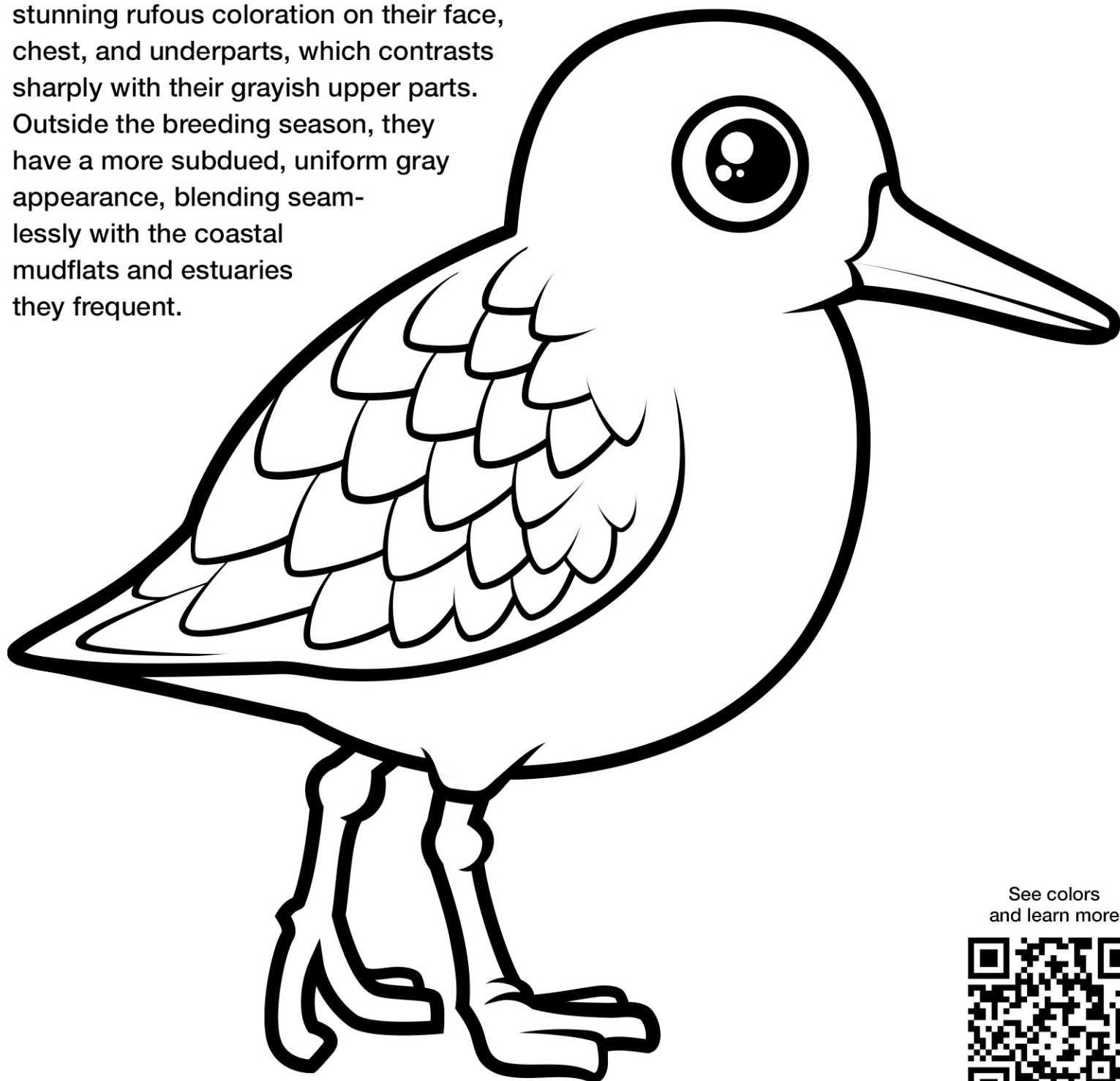


Red Knot

The Red Knot is a species of shorebird known for its extensive seasonal migration, traveling thousands of miles between its breeding grounds in the Arctic and wintering spots as far south as the southern tip of South America.

In breeding plumage, these birds showcase a stunning rufous coloration on their face, chest, and underparts, which contrasts sharply with their grayish upper parts. Outside the breeding season, they have a more subdued, uniform gray appearance, blending seamlessly with the coastal mudflats and estuaries they frequent.
